We have completed our review of your application to participate in the General Services Administration's (GSA) Centralized Household Goods Traffic Management Program (CHAMP) **International** Program. We have determined that your firm has met the requirements outlined in Section 2 of the Household Goods Tender of Service (HTOS) and has been granted conditional approval to participate.

In accordance with HTOS, Paragraph 2-12, GSA reserves the right to unilaterally increase or decrease the number of a carrier's approved traffic lanes for each rate filing cycle based on the carrier's annual Customer Satisfaction Index (CSI).
